# **RAMS Rally Update**

- 1. Spencer Bennett, RAMS Secretary/Treasurer and 2016 RAMS Rally Co-Chair gave a financial report on the 2016 Rally.
- 2. The Rally lost \$3.88 per registered attendee this year for a total loss of \$421.41. Spencer reported that he felt this was an acceptable loss, given the overall financial position of the organization and that is could be sustained into the foreseeable future.
- 3. Several members suggested that the 2017 information should be posted in the MOA and RA Magazines ASAP so as to get maximum publicity for next year. Spencer responded to this by pointing out that we do not know what the registration fee will be for next year as we are due to re-negotiate the contract with PCRV this year. He said he will submit the Ads as soon as the 2017 Rally price is set.
- 4. Spencer stated that he felt we should have a Rally Chair in place for 2017 rather than having the RAMS Officers act as Co-Chairs as it would relieve some of the work from the Officers and insure one point of contact for all Rally issues. The other officers concurred with this view at this time.
- 5. Spencer concluded his report by asking the RAMS Members to consider whether, given the reduced attendance, lower attendance by RAMS Members, and the general lack of support that has developed for the various rally chair positions and their staff, the RAMS wish to continue to conduct the RAMS Rally? Every year, he said, it becomes harder to recruit help and there are many times when folks just let things go until, this year, the officers stepped in to take care of the issue. He also pointed out that the 20 or so folks doing the work are getting a little weary and some have even said "I am not doing next year". If it is the will of the organization, he said, to continue the RAMS Rally, then some of the members need to come forth and support it more than in the past, both to help the current workers and to learn what each job entails so they can take it on at some point. There was some discussion of this matter ans some members felt that perhaps we could do parts of the rally (Bike Show, Poker Run) without having a rally and others felt that moving the rally to somewhere else might improve the attendance. There was the question asked "Why do we even need the rally?" Spencer asked everyone to consider the matter and perhaps we can discuss it further at the December or January Meeting

# The 2016 "Not In It To Win It" or NIITWIt Rally

The NIITWIt rally is a 12 hour or 36 hour riding rally that, for the 12 hour version, allows you to start anywhere you wish as long as it is within 12 riding hours of the finishing point at Mt. Magazine State Park Lodge in Paris, AR. The 36 hour version started at Vicksburg, MS this year but ended at the same location and time.

Since the 12 hour NIITWIt allowed me to start from home, and had many bonus sites in northeast Arkansas, it seemed a natural fit. I departed Hernando at 0603 on Saturday, October 22 for what turned out to be a very pleasant day of riding with the weather cooperating nicely for a change.

My first bonus site was the Sultana Memorial in Marion, AR and I found that one of the disadvantages of a rally in late October is that you have to wait for sunrise to get your picture, or light up the bonus with your headlight.



I did some of both and was soon on my way to the next stop in downtown Walnut Ridge, AR where there is a memorial to the Beatles (who knew?) to commemorate their visit to the community in 1964. The monument is a replication of the Abbey Road Album cover. Full details are available at the monument.




I got this photo with the help of a local who happened to be walking by when the crazy motorcyclist rode up, although I suspect from his demeanor that this is not the first time someone has asked for help with a picture here.

The ride continued on, stopping at assorted points of interest ranging from lakes to veterans monuments to military mistakes (one of the Titan II silos that blew up during the cold war). One of the nice things about this particular rally is that dawdling and flower sniffing is encouraged and they actually reward you for taking lunch breaks so I stopped in Heber Springs and took the 30 minute lunch break.

The latter part of the ride got a little bit more interesting as the bonus sites were located closer together and more were in town, so you had to spend more time riding in traffic, although most of the drivers were courteous when I had to make u turns in streets because I had ridden right past the library or the marker and had to get back and get the photo.

By 5:30 I found myself exiting Danville, AR after getting a photo of the first iron bridge in Yell County, erected in 1880 but no longer in service, and rolling on to the Mt. Magazine State Park.



The ride through the park up to the lodge is absolutely gorgeous with a wonderfully curvy road network and breathtaking views of the valley and the Petit Jean River below.

I arrived at the lodge and checked in by 5:45 so my scheduling worked out well and I apparently got as many points as I could have without going outside the time window, which is important (don't ask me how I know). Rosey joined me at the Lodge and we had a very good dinner there and the ride back on Sunday was almost as nice as the one over, with the weather continuing to cooperate.

If you get a chance, I would recommend trying one of these 12 hour rallies as they are challenging enough to plan that they keep your interest and short enough (most under 300 miles) that you can fit them in. All that is required is a street legal motorcycle, a map, and the ability to read and understand the directions.
