First, to let you know, that this note is long overdue. However, since I belong to an International Organization called "Procrastinators Lets Unite" (I believe that I am a charter member), therefore I am not doing too bad. But here is my story:

May of 2014, we had our RAMS meeting at the HUB in Arkansas, after our last fuel stop, I noticed a noise coming from the rear portion of my BMW K1200LT (LT i.e. light truck). But it was raining and therefore I did not stop but kept going (our fearless leader and president (Jim Linneman) of the RAMS looked at the weather map at the gas station told me that the rain was going to stop shortly. Boy, was he wrong! Next morning, with the bike on the center stand, I was trying to see if I could detect anything. No such luck. Kevin Mayfield had his CLYMER repair manual with him, Spencer Bennett and the manual we figured out exactly what I needed. My wife Shirley, came in her Mustang and so Saturday, early in the morning we drive to Rogers, Arkansas to a BMW MC dealer and we arrived there just as the opened the store and purchased new brake pads. After we returned to the HUB, Spencer Bennett did not go on the Saturday ride but installed the pads on to the Bike with my assistance (very, very little on On my part) and made it drivable once more. The upper brake pad is the outside one but has very little of the pad left, maybe 0.5mm

The lower one was the problem child - metal to metal contact-

August 2017 Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order by President Larry Craig on August 12, 2017 at 1:35 pm at My Favorite Place in Cordova, TN. There were 24 RAMS and 8 motorcycles present.

New Business

1) We have three new members for August:

John Holliday who lives in Memphis and rides an R1200 R.

Casey Harvell who lives in Memphis, TN..

Lovell Pratcher who lives in Memphis, TN.

- 2) We currently have 104 new and returning members for 2017.
- 3) There were no guests for the meeting.
- 4) Larry extended Thanks to the meeting hosts: Thank you Manchester Family!
- 5) Hank Widdop made a motion that the RAMS Annual Dues be increased to \$25.00 from the present \$15.00. His rational for the increase were:
 - He has noticed the RAMS Treasury has been going down about \$800.00 per year.
 - Other BMW Clubs in the area have dues ranging from \$20.00 to \$50.00 per year.
 - The increased income will allow the RAMS to reinstitute some things such as the printed Directory and to purchase some needed Club property such as a PA System for the RAMS Rally.

- The increase in Dues will require a Bylaws Revision which will require a 2/3 vote of members at two consecutive meetings following written notification of all members by mail.
- Bryan Leonard seconded the motion and the President opened the floor for discussion of the motion.

Robert Rehkopf stated that the club should live within its means and that no dues increase should be made until the current price/expense situation has been examined. He also stated that he felt that the RAMS Rally eats up all the energy and resources of the club and that the club should not be do anything that does not return a profit.

Hank responded to this by stating that he understood the purpose of the RAMS Rally was to be a social "payback" to the other Clubs that hold rallies that we attend and that there was an understanding that the cost of the rally would be structured so that it broke even at best.

Marshall Robilio pointed out that there has not been a Dues increase since at least 2003 and that depreciation and rising costs require that we raise dues to keep even with the expenses.

Rose-Anne Bennett stated that the Dues have not increased since she joined in 1996 and that she suspects the current dues rate was set in the late 1980's, so the need to increase them is reasonable given the 30 year run at the present rate.

Butch Turner concurred with Marshall on the matter of raising the dues to keep even with cost increase and to keep the club solvent.

Robert stated that we do not know if an increase is needed as we do not know the actual operating cost of the club (without rally expenses) and he felt that we should have that information prior to determining what the dues should be. He also stated that he did not want the club to subsidize the Rally from the dues income as he felt it was being conducted for non-RAMS and the dues should go for RAMS Members only.

Larry Craig pointed out that the Rally has been focused toward being an event "For the RAMS" for the past two years, with others invited to attend if they wish.

Robert asked how many RAMS attended the last Rally and Rose-Anne stated that 51 RAMS registered for the Rally. Robert questioned whether this amount of Rally support indicated that the "For the RAMS" program was working.

Larry asked if the additional dues cost would have an effect on families with multiple members and suggested that there be a "family rate" of some sort to ease this burden.

In answer to a question from the floor, Steve Clark stated that the cost of printing the Directory was about \$8.00 each and this had been a major cost item.

Jonathan Gifford noted that the Rally is the major activity of most BMW Clubs and provides a focal point for their activities during the year. He then suggested that we use this Bylaw revision process as an opportunity to revisit the current office holder positions of the RAMS with the idea of setting up a board of directors to oversee club operations. (I do not believe that this revision received a second but I include it here in the event it comes up at the September Meeting.)

At the conclusion of the discussion the motion was tabled until the September meeting when the first vote to begin the revision process. The Secretary/Treasurer was directed to make the mailing via post cards to all RAMS Members in accordance with the RAMS Bylaws and to prepare records that show the current yearly operating cost of the BMW RAMS without the RAMS Rally expense for the September Meeting.

The Motion that will be presented at the September Meeting will be to raise the current yearly RAMS Dues to \$25.00 via a revision to the RAMS Bylaws. This motion will be open to discussion and possible revision by those RAMS in attendance at the meeting.


